



Public Notice

Pursuant to State Law, a manual tally of at least 1% of the precincts, selected at random, is required as part of the post-Election Day canvass of the election.

This process, as are all components of the official canvass of results, is open to public observation. State Law provides 28 days to complete the canvass prior to certification of the election results.

The random selection of 1% of precincts to be manually tallied for the November 2, 2010 Gubernatorial General Election will commence on:

Wednesday, November 3rd at 1:30 p.m.

The actual manual tally of the votes cast on the ballots from those selected precincts will commence on:

Tuesday, November 9th at 9:00 a.m.

The manual tally will be conducted each day, until completed, during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. If needed, manual tally hours could be extended to evenings until 8:00 pm and/or weekends.
